

# Our Healing Ways Peer SuperVision Training

As a result of collaboration with the Victorian Dual Diagnosis Unit and our adoption of the “Our Healing Ways” SuperVision model, the AH&MRC are offering professional development workshops both in Sydney and throughout the state.

There are two key areas of training:

## **Part A - Group Peer Reflection**

This 2-day training educates you on what the supervision model is and how it is used. You experience the peer group supervision and gain confidence in how to participate effectively in a reflective peer supervision process.

Part A is open to all workers

## **Part B – One on One Peer Reflection**

This 3-day training for senior Aboriginal workers demonstrates how to apply the Cultural model of supervision, and provides a shared understanding of the nature of reflective practice. You learn the skills of how to be an effective peer supervisor and gain confidence in the process of peer supervision.

Part B is limited to those senior Aboriginal workers who have:

*Minimum 5 years direct service (practice experience) to clients and community + Cert IV or higher (in their field),*

or

*Minimum of 10 years direct service which includes counselling and some experience with supervision of their own practice*
