Pathways Program to a PhD is a three day intensive program offered by the UQ Poche Centre for Indigenous Health, designed for individuals looking to explore a career in health related research.

On completion of the Pathways Program to a PhD, you will gain an understanding of:

- What is a PhD
- Developing a PhD research question & proposal
- Insights into Indigenous methodologies
- How to apply for a PhD
- What support you can expect from UQ Poche.

During the program you will have opportunity to yarn with leading Indigenous Researchers and PhD students along with other key academic working in Indigenous Health.

#### Who is eligible to apply for the program?

Applicants must be Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander. They must also have an honours or masters degree, or already have 2 or more years experience working in research.

#### What area of study will this program support?

Public health, health services research, health promotion, medicine, allied health and nursing, social sciences, humanities, disease burden, big data surveillance and more.

#### How much does this program cost?

All costs to attend and participate in the program are included, however participants must be available to attend all three days of the program.
